CASE STUDY

A military family, who struggled with the aftermath of the father's trauma, said:

"We had the first family therapy session which focused on our healing rather than the details of Dad's trauma - our therapist helped us without needing to know the specific events. After the sessions, the changes were remarkable: Dad's nightmares ceased, the whole family became calmer, and we haven't experienced the household tensions that used to trigger everyone.

"The children are sleeping better, I've stopped my anxiety medication, and we're reconnected as a family. Dad can now hold down his job, and we're functioning as a unit again."

"Growing evidence shows that secondary trauma impacts entire households. As a charity, we believe that anyone traumatised in service, along with their family members, must have immediate access to effective therapy.

This treatment should be provided close to home, in a calm and pleasant environment, and should be free and prompt. Our FAITH programme shows that with proper family support, recovery rates have increased to over 68% in just one year, transforming thousands of lives across the UK."

PTSD Resolution is a charity assisting servicemen and women and family members, over the age of 12 years, with mental health issues following service in the UK armed forces.

- The charity works with both Veterans and families through FAITH (Family Assistance & Intervention for Trauma Healing), without requiring third-party referral or diagnosis, including those in prisons and with alcohol/drug problems.
- Recent data shows 17% of clients are family members (65% spouses/partners, 32% children, 3% parents/siblings) - we support the entire family unit affected by trauma.
- Through FAITH, 68% of the Veterans and family members who engage in therapy see their condition reliably improved, even with longstanding trauma.
- The charity is not a mental health crisis service those at immediate risk to life should contact The Samaritans on 116 123, their GP, mental health crisis team, or emergency services.
- Ongoing research demonstrates FAITH's effectiveness, showing a 68% reliable improvement for families receiving Human Givens Therapy (HGT).
- TATE -Trauma Awareness Training for Employers

FAITH is delivered through PTSD Resolution's network, accredited by the Royal College of Psychiatrists Quality Network for Veterans Mental Health Services.



WHAT WE DO

- Post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) may affect entire family units, not just the Veteran.
- A Veteran's symptoms impact household stability through flashbacks, nightmares, anger, and depression, leading to family tension and breakdown.
- FAITH provides free, prompt mental health treatment to Veterans, Reservists and family members, over the age of 12 years, through 200 Human Givens qualified therapists, available online or locally.
- Treatment averages seven sessions, focusing on recovery and reintegration into normal life without creating dependency.
- Our approach breaks the cycle of family trauma, enabling households to heal together in a calm, supported environment.
- Therapy is conducted humanely, respecting family privacy without requiring detailed trauma discussions. No diagnosis or referral is needed.
